1. Before reading and listening to the story (pre čitanja!), look at the pictures below the text and describe them:

(*preporuka – opišite slike na engleskom nekome od ukućana, ili pozovite telefonom drugare iz razreda pa radite zajedno)

Slede pitanja koja će vam pomoći da započnete:

Look at picture A. Where is the man sitting? What is he doing?

Is the man sitting on the pavement happy? Can you tell how he's feeling? What's in picture B? Look at picture C. What's the man doing? Where is he going? Is it a long walk? What has he got in his right hand? What is he carrying on the stick? (Something wrapped up with a cloth.) What's in the cloth? – Guess

Dodatak (sinonimi/objašnjenja)

Tailor – a person whose job is to make clothes, especially for men (krojač)

Dressmaker – a person who makes women's clothes (koja je to reč na srpskom?)

Once upon a time there was..... A typical beginning of a fairy tale (Nekada davno, živeo je jedan...)

Hard (ad) – with great effort or energy (naporno, marljivo) *adverb – prilog (vrsta reči)
(They worked **hard** all their lives.)

Fall asleep – zaspati

(I didn't watch the end of the film, I **fell asleep**.)

Strange – odd (neobičan, čudan) He had a **strange** dream.

Set off- to start a journey

Busy (adj) – (of places) full of people and activities (prometan) **busy** road/airport
- having much work to do (zauzet)

Don't disturb him, he's **busy** learning English.

Towards – in the direction of something/someone (prema,ka)
